CALIFORNIA

onterey, Carmel, PEBBLE BEACH: This stretch of coastline, located near the famous 17-Mile-Drive on the Californian coast is not only a paradise for golfers, but also home to the PEBBLE BEACH CONCOURS D'ELEGANCE automobile show with a view of windswept pines and impressive summer villas directly on the rocky beach facing the Pacific. The entrepreneur Ulrich Schmid-Maybach, none other than the great-grandson and grandson of Wilhelm and Karl Maybach, is of course there every year. Maybach lives in San Francisco, not far from Pebble Beach, just a two-hour drive away, and he knows what he owes to the inventiveness of his ancestors.

Pistons, cylinders, crankshafts, and camshafts as well as spark plugs in petrol engines and injection nozzles in diesel engines are key components of internal combustion engines. The 20th century will go down in history as the century of the combustion engine and the passion for driving. Maybach, Ferrari, Porsche, Bugatti, Jaguar, and many other legendary brands bear witness to the fascination of mobility on four wheels, racing, and road trips. All ideologies that have tried to spoil the car have so far failed, all attempts to standardize the diversity of human desires and to impose the electric car at all costs have failed.

Passionate inventors and charismatic personalities define the character of a car. Their influence can still be felt today in vehicles with internal combustion engines. The legendary models of these personalities can still be marveled at today at important shows, not only in America, but in Europe.



ITALY

Arguably the most beautiful event takes place at the end of May, on the grounds of the magnificent VILLA D' ESTE on LAKE COMO. The pleasure of visiting the CONCORSO D' ELEGANZA attracts not only car and technology enthusiasts, but also people interested in history, design, and art. The Concorso d'Eleganza is more than just a show of classic cars; it is a celebration of elegance, charm, and cultural heritage.

The Villa d'Este itself is a luxurious grand hotel, known for its magnificent gardens and historic architecture. The scenery is framed by the rolling hills around Lake Como, which contribute to a wonderful atmosphere for the automobiles of yesteryear. The participants in the competition and the collectors are illustrious, often wealthy personalities who offer an unforgettable showcase of the most beautiful classic cars from all over the world, including brands such as Ferrari, Bugatti, Rolls Royce, and many others.

Each vehicle tells its own story and brings with it a touch of nostalgia. The vehicles, which cost many millions and are considered masterpieces of automotive design, are often the result of decades of care and restoration. As a rule, the public dresses elegantly and acknowledges the parade of vehicles with a cheerful mood, passion, and enthusiasm.



FRANCE

The French counterpart, **CHANTILLY ARTS & ELEGANCE**, takes place just outside Paris at the historic Château de Chantilly. The combination of historic architecture and beautiful scenery creates an atmosphere of elegance and sophistication that enchants visitors and collectors alike.

The show presents not only classic vintage cars, but also exceptional sports cars, hyper cars, and unique prototypes, such as the recent DSSM Tribute. The highlight of the event is the competition, in which outstanding cars are awarded prizes in various categories. A jury of experts evaluates the vehicles in terms of originality, restoration quality and design. The grand finale is a show in front of thousands of visitors, during which all the nominated vehicles take a spin and are presented by the jury. The fact that sometimes one of the veterans gets stuck and must be pushed to its destination with combined forces adds to the fun. Dinner is traditionally served on the castle lawns with checkered tablecloths, champagne, and braided picnic baskets.

ENGLAND

The traditional FESTIVAL OF SPEED, which takes place annually at the picturesque GOODWOOD HOUSE in SUSSEX. is distinctly rural and traditionally British. It has established itself as one of the most outstanding and spectacular events for automobile enthusiasts worldwide. The historical backdrop includes Goodwood House, an impressive manor house surrounded by extensive gardens. The circuit or racetrack is secured by traditional straw bales. An extraordinary variety of vehicles can be seen, ranging from classic vintage cars and modern super sports cars to historic racing cars and motorcycles.

The event brings together a wide range of car makes and models. This diversity attracts not only car enthusiasts, but also families and people from different fields of interest. Famous drivers and other motorsport legends also make regular appearances at the Festival of Speed - the opportunity to see these personalities driving and signing autographs is a highlight for visitors.

The centerpiece of the festival is the infamous Hillclimb course, which leads through the picturesque Goodwood countryside. This circuit is approximately 1.16 miles long and challenges drivers to master their cars on this demanding course. The opportunity to see classic and modern racing cars on the track as they reach their top speed is well worth the visit.

In addition, the Festival of Speed also attempts to look into the future of motorsport by addressing topics such as electromobility, sustainable drive technologies and innovations in automotive engineering. In addition to classic vehicles, modern electric vehicles and their performance in the automotive industry are also presented. You can spend the night in small guesthouses and bed & breakfast accommodation in the nearby picturesque towns.

Like the Concours of Elegance at Hampton Court Palace, the automobile competition has an international focus and brings together the world's most important collectors to celebrate their vehicles in a spectacular setting. Likewise, the overall winner is not chosen by a jury, but by the owners of the vehicles themselves.

The sound of the powerful engines, the smell of petrol and burnt rubber, the feeling of speed and the breathtaking designs of the vehicles create a unique atmosphere at all the events mentioned. Guests can experience the vehicles in motion and up close and easily strike up conversations with collectors who are happy to talk about their passion and the painstaking restoration work they do.
